

Q: What is UL924?

A: UL924 is the Underwriter's Laboratories standard for "emergency lighting and power equipment ... intended to automatically supply illumination or power or both to critical areas and equipment in the event of failure of the normal supply, in accordance with Article 700 or 701 of the National Electrical Code, NFPA 70, the Life Safety Code, NFPA 101, the Fire Code, NFPA 1, the International Building Code, IBC, and the International Fire Code, IFC."

LVS products undergo the UL924 testing and listing process to ensure compliance with all codes and regulations.

LVS manufactures 2 categories of UL924 device:

- 1) Automatic Load Control Relays (ALCR's) which include all products in the EPC and RRU family.
- 2) Inverters which includes the CEPS-850 850 Watt emergency lighting inverter.
